Nature of support 2012/13

The funding for the Pupil Premium has been allocated in the following ways:

- Reading, writing and maths intervention e.g. Better Reading Partnerships, Guided Maths, teaching coaches
- Funded 6 weekly trips and experiences including residentials
- Free books sent home for every child
- Learning Mentors to support identified children in making accelerated progress
- Additional Family Support Worker
- Wellbeing fund for the children of families in crisis (e.g funded bus passes and school uniform)
- Attendance prizes

Outcomes 2012/13

Progress in Reading KS1-KS2 = 82% achieved expected progress (National 84%)

Progress in Writing KS1- KS2 = 82% achieved expected progress (National 89%)

Progress in Maths KS1 – KS2 = 82% achieved expected progress (National 84%)

63% of FSM children achieved a level 4 in Reading, Writing and Maths combined (National 64%)

76% of FSM children achieved a pass in the Phonics Screening Check (National 57%)
