

Pupil Premium

The Pupil Premium is additional funding given to publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

For the period 1st April 2018 – 31st March 2019 we have received £310,200 to improve the attainment of these pupils.

Main barriers:

1. Learning behaviours
2. Gaps in basic skills and age related knowledge
3. Poor language and vocabulary skills
4. Attendance/lateness
5. Wellbeing needs
